HISTORY

CIRCOLO VELICO RAVENNATE is a reality historical for Italian sailing, founded in 1949, it became a fundamental Federal Preparation Center for the sport, local office, sailing school e national match race center. He has organized great events importance, he trained pupils that yes they are honored on most race courses important: America's Cup, Olympics, Whitbread Round The World Race, Admiral's Cup. The goal in training is accompany students on a path from sailing school to competition, preparing them on all topics necessary to train a sailor business suit. He has been involved in the organization for years of nautical events ranging from teams building at international regattas.





CLUB

Competitions, regattas, international sporting events, cruises, great friendships and sailing education but, above all, an impressive contribution to the development of seafaring culture that traditionally belongs to this land. This is the Ravenna Sailing Club: an association non-profit sports, born in 1949 on the initiative of a group of friends who are passionate about the sea, and that today it has about 600 members. The Circolo Velico Ravennate is affiliated to the Federation Italiana Vela, in 1989 was awarded by CONI with the Silver Star and in 2013 with the Gold Star at sporting merit, it also hosts the headquarters of the XI Committee Area (Emilia Romagna) of the Italian Sailing Federation, as well as the Zonal Federal Center of the XI Zone. The Club has its headquarters near the building of the Lighthouse in Marina of Ravenna. The headquarters has a total structure of approximately 65,000 square meters. and yes it subdivides into a site on land and one in the sea.

MATCH RACE

The Circolo Velico Ravennate has always organized Match Race events.

Until 2007 the maximum event organized was the MATCH RACE ROBERTO TROMBINI, first Swedish Match Toour and after World Match Racing Tour.

In addition to The Trombini from 2010 to today there have been repeated match race events including many editions of the Italian Match Race Championship.

To date, Circolo Velico Ravennate is a federal reference center for this specialty.





RACE AREA

Marina di Ravenna is the ideal place for match races as it is possible to regatta both inside the dam basin and in the open sea, always sheltered from the waves.

The typical sea breeze of the May/September period comes from E and S/E.





RAVENNA

Ravenna is a city of art and culture, and a mosaic centre that 1600 years ago became capital three times: of the Western Roman Empire first, of Theodoric King of the Goths then and finally of the Byzantine Empire in Europe. The magnificence of this period has honoured Ravenna with a great heritage of historical buildings. There are no less than eight monuments declared World Heritage by Unesco.

The art of mosaics, an ancient craft that survived in workshops and artisan shops, did not originate in Ravenna but its greatest expression is to be found here. It was here that Christian iconology originated, a mixture of symbolism and realism, of Roman and Byzantine influence.

There's much more than the stunning beauty of the mosaics: in Ravenna one can stroll among the bell-towers and monastic cloisters, passing from Romanesque to Gothic, from the Giotto - like frescoes of Santa Chiara - to the Baroque art of the apsis in Sant'Apollinare Nuovo, from the records of the last refuge of Dante Alighieri to the Palaces that saw the loves of Lord Byron.

Whoever sees Ravenna falls in love with it today just as it happened in the past: from to Boccaccio who set one of his most beautiful novels here, to Gustav Klimt who drew obvious inspiration from the art, to Hermann Hesse who dedicated some verses to it while visiting.

Ravenna is Roman, Gothic, Byzantine and also medieval, Venetian and finally modern, civil and hospitable, with abundant cultural events and prestigious international occasions that project it into the future.
