Sailing in national and international events through Europe and some world championships. In 1997, I was boat captain for an offshore sailor on the Solitaire du Figaro. It gave me the skills of duties and obligations of the shore teams and coaches.

Brief summary of professional background and business skills

My knowledge and skills are based on several years of practice in professional life and also during sailing events based indeed on the same skills: listening, building and reaching targets, each time in a team. I really enjoy the human side of the work, creating synergy!
